FREEDOM OF INFORMATION REQUEST - RESPONSE
FOI Reference: OPTUM FOI 500-923– SWL CCG

I refer to your email received on 12 March 2020. I can confirm on behalf of NHS South West Lincolnshire Clinical Commissioning Groups (CCG) supported by Optum Commissioning Support Services, and in accordance with S.1 (1) of the Freedom of Information Act 2000 (FOIA) that we do not hold the information you have requested. A response to each element of your request is detailed below:

REQUEST

1. Does your CCG commission a community VTE clinic?
2. In the last 12 months how many patients have been treated at the clinic?
3. How many patients have been treated with a DOAC within the clinic?
4. Of these patients how many were treated with:
 - a. Xarelto
 - b. Lixiana
 - c. Pradaxa
 - d. Eliquis

RESPONSE

In response to question 1 above, please be advised the CCG does not commission a community VTE Clinic. Therefore, the CCG does not hold the information requested and cannot provide suitable responses to questions 2 to 4 above. For information, we are aware that VTE clinics are not commissioned in community or primary care.
