



## How to Book your Vaccination Appointment at a Large Vaccination Centre

1. You will receive a letter from the NHS when you are eligible to book your Covid 19 vaccination.
2. The letter will include a website address that you need to visit to book your vaccination, you will be presented with the screen below when you log on to the website. Please click “book a coronavirus vaccination” as highlighted below.




3. Once you have clicked on to the next screen you will be given some information about what will happen at your vaccination appointment, once you have read this please scroll to the bottom of the page and click start now.








4. You will be asked if you know your NHS number, this number can be located on the top right of the letter you received from the NHS, Click “Yes, I Know my NHS number” and continue
5. You will be asked to input your NHS number, please type the 10 digit number that is printed in the top right of the letter you received from the NHS and click continue.




6. You will then be asked a number of questions, examples of which are below, please answer each of these and click continue.



7. Once you have answered these questions and clicked continue, you will be asked for your home postcode, this is so that we can identify which of the centres are closest to you. Once you have entered your postcode please click "Find a vaccination centre"



8. You will be presented with a list of large vaccination centres and pharmacies that have available appointments, starting with those closest to your home.



9. If you click on the name of the vaccination centre it will give you a list of available appointments at this site, once you have selected the slot that you wish to attend you will be able to confirm your Covid 19 vaccination.
  
10. If you do not want to book an appointment at the centres that are listed, you can visit the site again at a later date when more appointments may have been made available, or you can wait for your local GP led vaccination site to contact you offering you an appointment. You do not need to do anything.
