Public consultation relating to four of Lincolnshire's NHS Services



NHS Lincolnshire Clinical Commissioning Group (CCG) has recently begun a formal consultation exercise on the future of four local hospital services. This 12 week public consultation is our biggest public consultation to date and will enable people from across the county to have their say on how these services might be delivered in the future.

The services being consulted on are:

- Orthopaedics (elective and non-elective) countywide
- Stroke services countywide
- Urgent and emergency care at Grantham hospital
- Acute medicine at Grantham hospital

As part of this consultation, we will be sharing extensive information on the above services, how they operate now, the challenges faced and our proposals for how they could be improved for the population of Lincolnshire.

We want to engage and involve you in this conversation –helping us to shape what the future of these services look like together.
